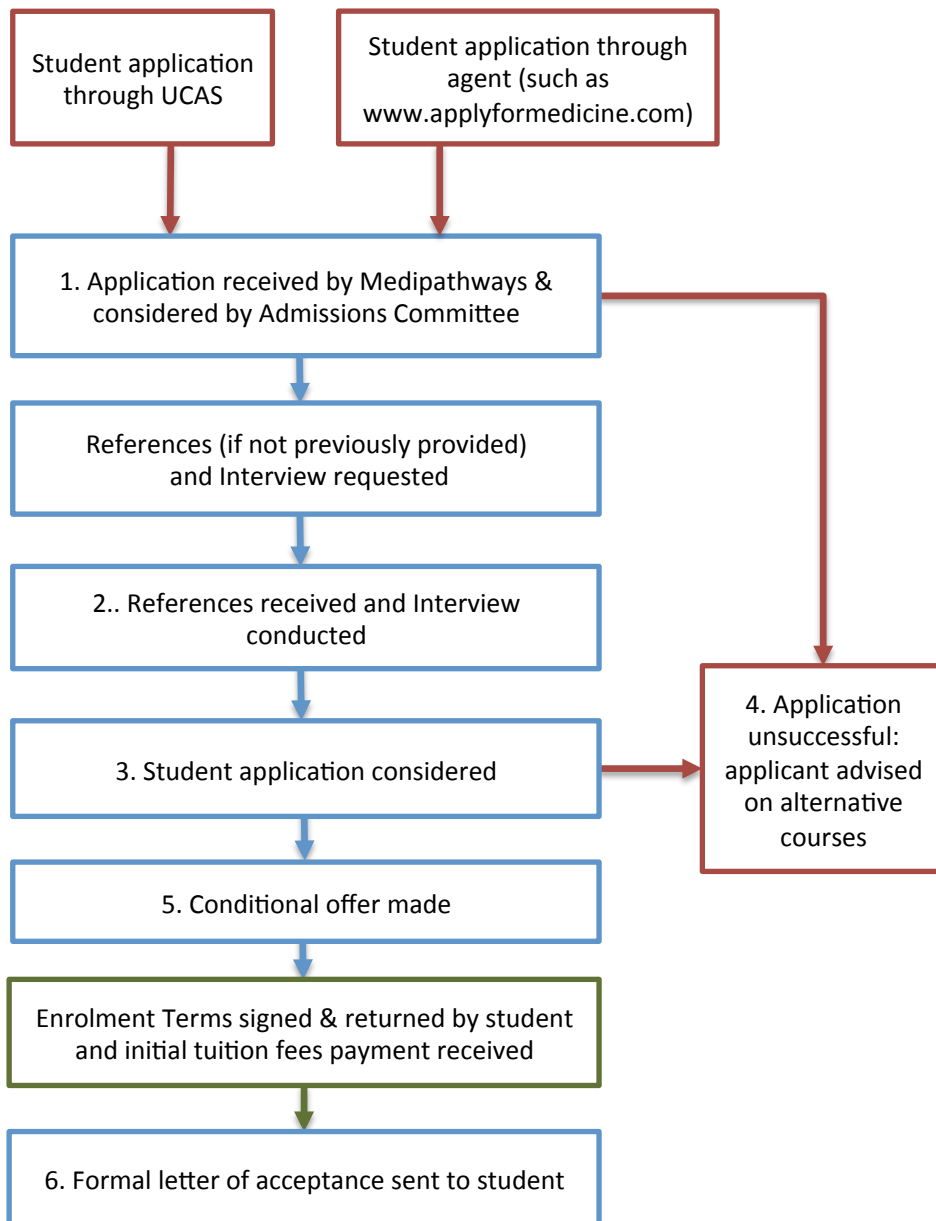


2015-16 Medipathways Admissions Process



Further details

1. Initial checks are taken to confirm that all necessary documents have been received and that the applicant has, or is predicted, to achieve the academic and language prerequisites of the course. These prerequisites are determined in consultation of the UCAS guidelines and relevant HEI criteria. These ordinarily take place Jan – Mar.
2. Interviews are usually required at Medipathways. These can take place remotely by video-link if more convenient. These ordinarily take place Mar-May.
3. The decision about making conditional offers to applicants is made by the Admissions Committee. This will ordinarily take place within 2 weeks of interview.
4. Unsuccessful BSc and Pre-Med applicants will usually be advised that the Medipathways Foundation course is suitable for those who do not meet the required academic standards of the BSc and Pre-Med. Unsuccessful applicants will be advised on alternative courses. This process is also used for applicants who do not meet their conditional offer.
5. This will usually include academic and language qualifications and a deposit. Offers are ordinarily made within 2 weeks of interview and should be accepted or otherwise by the end of August. With clearing students this is negotiable.
6. Following the letter of acceptance, students are granted access to preparatory materials, such as those available on our VLE. These materials include term dates and details of induction. The new student is added to the relevant student roster. Students cannot be accepted onto our courses more than three teaching weeks after the start of term.
